The DIL-300 functions as an interface between the Sun-1805(-9), Sun-1805Z, MEA-1500 or the MCA-3000 Host Testers and specific vehicles having a Distributorless Ignition System.

HOST TESTER COMPATIBILITY

SUN ELECTRIC CORPORATION

The DIL-300 is designed to work on the above mentioned testers ONLY. Particular software and hardware requirements to these testers must be met to support the DIL-300. See Figure 1 below for requirements. NOTE: If the Host Tester is already capable of supporting a **DIL-200** Serial "B", no changes will be necessary to support the DIL-300.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Before being used, the DIL-300 <u>must</u> be calibrated to ensure matching of the DIL-300 to it's associated Host Tester. Calibration of the DIL-300 consists of adjusting the Analog Pattern Processing circuitry and the Secondary Output Gain. The Analog Pattern Processing circuitry is factory adjusted and calibration ONLY needs to be performed whenever either the Pattern Pickup Cable Assembly #6004-0544 or D.I.S. Processor PCB Assembly 7001-2075-01 is replaced.

NOTE : ONLY the **DIL-300** SECONDARY GAIN ADJUST procedure MUST BE performed upon initial equipment setup or whenever the **DIL-300** is transferred to another Host Tester.

SECONDARY GAIN ADJUSTMENT

Prior to performing the following procedure, refer to the MEA 1500 Service Manual and perform VERTICAL CHECKOUT/CALIBRATION procedures in Chapter 4, page 4-15; or the SUN-1805 Service Manual and perform the firing and spark KV procedures in Chapter 11, Page 110, or the MCA-3000 Service Manual and perform the KV calibration in Chapter 9, page 9-9.

- 1. Turn Host Tester on.
- 2. A. If the host tester is a SUN-1805(Z), advance to the PROGRAM SETUP page. Enter vehicle code 438 (load limits first if an 1805Z) and advance to the PROGRAM SELECTION MENU. Select the DYNAMIC FIRING KV PAGE by pressing #8 on the remote.
 - B. If the host tester is a MEA-1500, advance to the VEHICLE SETUP page. Enter 6 cyl. and 4 cycle and then advance to the VEHICLE TEST page. Select DISPLAY, SECONDARY, and LOW SCALE(25KV) on the remote.
 - C. If the host tester is an MCA-3000, enter vehicle code 438 in the Vehicle ID page and advance the DYNAMIC KV page from the PINPOINT MENU. Use the CONT key to advance to the DYNAMIC FIRING KV Page.
- 3. Connect the TRIGGER pick-up of the Host Tester to IS-100A TRIGGER loop.

- 4. Connect the Blue PATTERN lead of the Host Tester to the PATTERN LEAD connector on DIL-300.
- 5. Connect the blue-booted primary clip and black-booted ground clip from the Host Tester's UNIVERSAL harness to the PRIMARY (-) side of the coil and the GROUND lug on the IS-100A respectively.

NOTE: If the Host Tester is a MEA-1500 or MCA-3000, DO NOT connect the Yellow-booted lead to the (+) side of the coil.

- 6. Connect the 14-pin connector of either the D.I.S. Module Cable Assembly 7009-1867 (from the GM Cable Kit) or the Universal Cable #6004-0590-01 (from the Ford cable kit) to the IGNITION MODULE connector on the DIL-300. Connect the pink twin flex RED and BLACK clips to ALT VOLTS/OHMS lugs on IS-100A.
- 7. Connect the 4-pin connector of the Secondary Calibration Cable #6004-0500 to the SECONDARY PICK-UPS connector on the **DIL-300.** Connect the other end of the Calibration Cable to the Calibrated Secondary Output terminal on the IS-100A.

- 9. Insert the Generic Personality Cartridge into the **DIL-300** cartridge receptacle. The Ford or GM Personality Cartridge may be used in place of the Generic Personality Cartridge.
- 10. The top cover of the DIL 300 must be removed to gain access to the pots located on the left side of the DIL-300. Remove the six screws that secure the top of the DIL 300. Remove the top cover carefully as the keypad will be suspended by its attaching ribbon cable.
- 10. Momentarily press the POWER switch on DIL-300 and verify that the POWER LED lights.
- 11. If using the Generic Personality Cartridge, select "6Cyl" by pressing the corresponding number on the DIL-300 Keypad. If using the GM Personality Cartridge select "3.8 Liter, Type I" engine. If using the Ford Personality Cartridge, select the "3.0L, SHO" engine.
- 12. Adjust the MIDDLE pot R71 on the DIL-300 to read as indicated in either 12A, 12B or 12C.
 - A. If the Host Tester is a SUN-1805, adjust R71 until all six live DYNAMIC FIRING KV readings are 16.5KV +/- 0.1 KV.
 - B. If the Host Tester is a MEA-1500, adjust R71 until all six firing lines are at 16.5 KV +/- 0.5 KV on the LOW SCALE (25 KV).
 - C. If the Host Tester is an MCA-3000, adjust R71 until all the cylinders in the RESULTS column read 16.5KV +/- 0.1KV.

DIL " 300" DISPLAY BRICHTNESS CONTROL

- 1. Power the unit up.
- 2. Adjust the TOP pot R125 until the background raster disappears. Then adjust until the background raster becomes faintly visible.
- 3. Turn off power to the unit.
- 4. Position the keypad and place the top cover on the unit. Insert the six screws that secure the top and tighten.
