INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:	

NOTE: STEPS 1 THROUGH 6 WILL REQUIRE TWO OR MORE PEOPLE.

- 1. Cut and remove the straps. Remove the top of the shipping carton.
- 2. Remove the carton by sliding the carton over top of the unit.
- 3. Remove unit-packing material from around the sides of the unit.
- 4. Carefully slide the unit and foam base partially off of the shipping pallet.
- 5. Lean the SunSG so that the shipping pallet and half of the foam base can be removed.
- 6. Lean the *SunSG* so that other half of the foam base can be removed.
- 7. Remove tape from ALL drawers and covers.
- 8. Remove bubble wrap from Keyboard, located in the keyboard drawer.
- 9. Inventory all items using the Parts & Accessories List and inspect for damage. The Unit Accessories and the Literature Kit are located in the bottom drawer of the unit.

NOTE: ANY SOFTWARE OR HARDWARE, OWNERS' MANUALS AND PRE-LOADED SOFTWARE THAT COME WITH THE COMPUTER, SUCH AS MICROSOFT® WINDOWS® 98, ARE LOCATED IN THE BOTTOM DRAWER OF THE UNIT.

NOTE: ANY REGISTRATION CARDS FOR THE INSTALLED SOFTWARE SUCH AS MICROSOFT® WINDOWS® 98 MUST BE FILLED OUT AND SENT IN BY THE CUSTOMER TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH ANY SOFTWARE LICENSING AGREEMENTS.




Figure 1, Monitor Base Plate

- 10. The monitor is shipped separately from the unit. Locate the monitor box.
- 11. Remove the monitor from the box and inspect the monitor for damage. Discard the AC Cable supplied with the monitor.
- 12. Set the monitor against the **back** bracket on the base plate as shown in figure 1.
- 13. Slide the front bracket snug up to the front of the monitor and tighten the nuts of the brackets.
- 14. Fasten the Velcro straps over the top of the monitor and snug down.
- 15. Connect the video cable to "video" port on the left side of the *SunSG*.
- 16. Connect the power cord to the monitor.

NOTE: THE LIGHT PEN HOLDER IS INSTALLED "ONE TIME ONLY". AFTER IT IS INSTALLED AND REMOVED IT WILL NOT STICK PROPERLY A SECOND TIME.

- 17. Locate the Light Pen Holder. Fasten it to the left side of the monitor so that the light pen (2-7042) can be inserted from the front.
- 18. Connect the Light Pen cable to the **Light Pen** Connector, located on the left side toward the back of the tester.
- 19. Using the Black Plastic Tie Wrap (5-2345), tie down the Light Pen Cord so that if it is dropped it will not hit the floor. Fasten the tie wrap to the monitor base where the Velcro strap is.
- 20. Locate the printer paper (0528-1088-01) in the bottom drawer. Load printer paper into paper tray in the bottom of the printer. Install a maximum of 100 sheets in the printer. Store the rest in the bottom drawer.

21. Hook up the leads according to the following chart.

- 22. Power up the unit.
- 23. Unit will boot up. After boot up it will automatically do a scandisk and go into the Microsoft® Windows® 98 Setup Wizard.
- 24. Enter the Store Number and Manager's Name and select **NEXT >**.
- 25. Read the licensing agreement. Select the *I accept the agreement* option to continue the setup and select **NEXT>**.
- 26. Type in the Product Key as it appears on the Windows Certificate of Authenticity shipped with the Windows® 98. Select **NEXT>**. Select **FINISH**.
- 27. Type SUNSG in the User Name field. Select **OK.**

NOTE: DO NOT ENTER A PASSWORD.

- 28. At the Add New Hardware Wizard select **NEXT>**.
- 29. Select Search for Best Driver for your Device. (Recommended). Select **NEXT>**, **NEXT>**, **NEXT>**. Select **FINISH**.
- 30. Verify the date and times are correct. If not, make the necessary corrections and Select APPLY.
- 31. Press CANCEL.
- 32. System settings are updated automatically and the *SunSG* application starts.
